The Governor of the North West Region informs the public and especially stockbreeders that there are false documents in circulation in the Region and even beyond which for reasons of hegemony and personal prestige, prohibit the sale of horses.

Recalling that the breeding and selling of horses are neither prohibited by the Cameroon laws nor by any religion, this decision by an individual or group of individuals shall not be tolerated and shall be considered as null and void.

Consequently, the about thirty horses confiscated by these selfish and anarchistic individuals should be returned to their owners immediately or they will run the risk of prosecution for despoilment and arbitrary detention of another person's goods.

The Governor invites stockbreeders, owners and dealers in horses to systematically report all those who seize horses on the way to the different markets to Administrative Authorities and to the Forces of Law and Order.

He also requests elements of the Forces of Law and Order never to get involved in the execution of this disastrous activity whose initiators are champions in influence peddling and could use any strategy to compromise them.

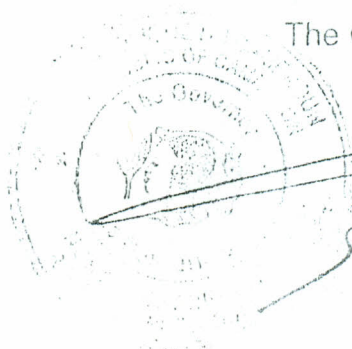

He finally reminds the public that any complicity with these fraudulent activities shall be severely punished, in total disregard of the identity of the author.
