Mr. Nasaka of the Procureur General's Chambers for the
prosecution.

Mrs. Sendze, Mr. Abongwa and Mr. Sama Nchunu for the defence.
Mr. Sama Francis for the civil claimant absent.

Court Note: Mr. Nasako says he is ready to go on with one
witness, Mr. Nasako now says he wants an adjournment because
only the investigator is in court.

Mrs. Sendze on behalf of the Defence objects to the
application for the reason that the matter has been adjourned
seven times. The reasons given by the prosecution has always
been the same; that he wants to get the prosecution witnesses
appear in court. We submit that the prosecution is not pre-
pared to prosecute the defendants. We urge the court to
strike out the matter for lack of diligent prosecution.

Ruling: Considering that this matter has suffered
seven adjournments and that these adjournments have for the
most part been at the instance of the prosecution; further
considering that it was adjourned to this date for the last
time, the charge is dismissed under Section 280 of the
Criminal Procedure Ordinance for lack of diligent prosecution.

"WHEREFORE, the President of the Republic of Cameroon
commands and enjoins all Bailiffs and Process servers to
enforce this Ruling the Procureur General and the State Counsel
to lend them support, and all commanders and Officers of the
Armed forces and the Police Forces to lend them assistance
whensoever required by law".
