

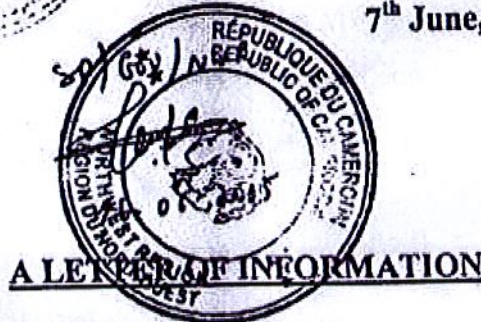

Dear Sir,



We the Esu Youths, humbly wish to table this our letter of information before your high office, consisting of our plans about part of our land worth about ten thousand (10,000) hectares.

Sir, one Alhadji Baba Dan Pullo claims that the land is his permanent land. The Esu people have severally invited him for peace talks about the land and severally has he assured them of showing up but to no avail. The most recent time he unsuccessfully promised to come was through the effort of the Senior Divisional Officer for Menchum who encouraged him to meet the Esu people for peace talks. The land he claims to be his is just a stone through from Esu town. Therefore Sir, our reasons for deciding to reclaim our land which we are already in the process, is mindful of the following facts;


- 1) That the land was temporally given to him by Late Fon Buh II Joseph Meh who was so generous and welcoming. He assured Alhadji that the land was for temporal usage and not for the planting of pillars since the Esu population is fast growing.
- 2) That the Esu population has geometrically grown and is still growing alarmingly thereby rendering its inhabitants to lack building and farming space.
- 3) That land is a fixed factor as compared with the elastic nature of the population.

- 4) That after gaining a lot of grounds on the temporal land that was given to him at wundele, he took advantage and destroyed crops and the villages of Ewo and Kedzong thereby rendering the villagers homeless and starved. Some even died due to stress, heartbreak, confusion and famine.
- 5) That he has willfully and vehemently refused to attend to our invitations for peace talks, and
- 6) That many Esu people are suffering without crimes in prison jailed by him under the canopy of trespassing on his land.

We deemed it an unavoidable necessity to inform you our father and the highest personality in the North West Region of Cameroon about the reclamation of our land from Alhadji Baba Dan Pullo since he does not want to attend to us for re-allocation Sir, it is really above our imagination thereby influencing our current action why a single person will forcefully like to seize about half of our land without any legal verifiable document.

Sir, for the sake of peace to reign in our town in particular, it is either he sooner than later meets us or we continue with the partial to be immediately followed by total reclamation of our land. We will thus be very grateful and appreciative if our information is understood and our action supported for justice to reign. Thanks

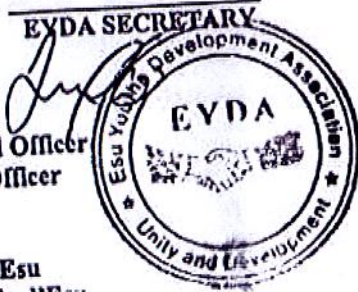
